

GOOD JUDGMENT- KINDERGARTEN

Book and Lesson will be together in the media center. Materials are in the cabinet immediately to your left when you enter the media center.

Materials:

Book- *Hunches in Bunches* by Dr. Seuss

Activity:

Lead discussion with students: What does good judgment mean?

-making good choices

-thinking before you act

Examples- coming to school, taking care of our bodies, listening to the teacher, following directions

Display definition and read aloud

Introduce book, *Hunches in Bunches* by Dr. Seuss. Show the cover of the book. Ask students to make a prediction. What will this book be about?

Read *Hunches in Bunches*, stopping periodically to discuss.

After reading the story, what happens when all the hunches try to make decisions? (it gets very confusing, it is hard to make a choice)

Questions:

Who is in charge of making decisions? (only you!)

Ask the class to give a thumbs up if they have ever had to make a hard decision.

Students can share times they showed good judgment and were able to think before they acted.
