

INTEGRITY – SECOND GRADE

Book and Lesson will be together in the media center. Materials are in the cabinet immediately to your left when you enter the media center.

Materials:

Book: *Jackalope* by Janet Stevens and Susan Stevens Crummel
Honesty Poster

Activity:

Lead discussion with students. What is integrity? What do adults mean when they say you should act with integrity?

- Being honest
- Doing the right thing
- Keeping your word
- Treating others as you want to be treated

Is it always easy to act with integrity? Discuss.

Read *Jackalope*.

Which character showed integrity? (the mirror, and the hare did not like the mirror's honesty so he tried to be something that he is not.)

Why didn't the hare treat the mirror with respect? (because the mirror was honest)

Was that the right thing to do? (no) Why is it good to be honest and show integrity?

Questions:

Ask students to share about a time they showed integrity at home or at school.

- Return an item that you find on the ground
- Tell the truth to teachers, parents and friends
- Admit when you do something wrong
- Return a borrowed item or keep promises by doing what you say you will
